SAE AS1390, “Level of Repair Analysis (LORA),” was adopted on 08 OCT 2014 for use by the Department of Defense (DoD). This standard establishes general requirements and provides descriptions of specific activities which define the LORA process throughout the life cycle of products or equipment. SAE AS1390 is a new and improved replacement for the cancelled MIL-STD-1390 “Level of Repair Analysis.”
